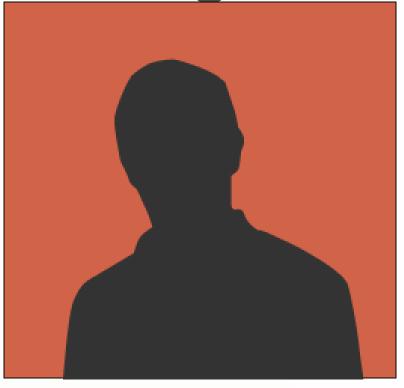

Good Communication = Planning

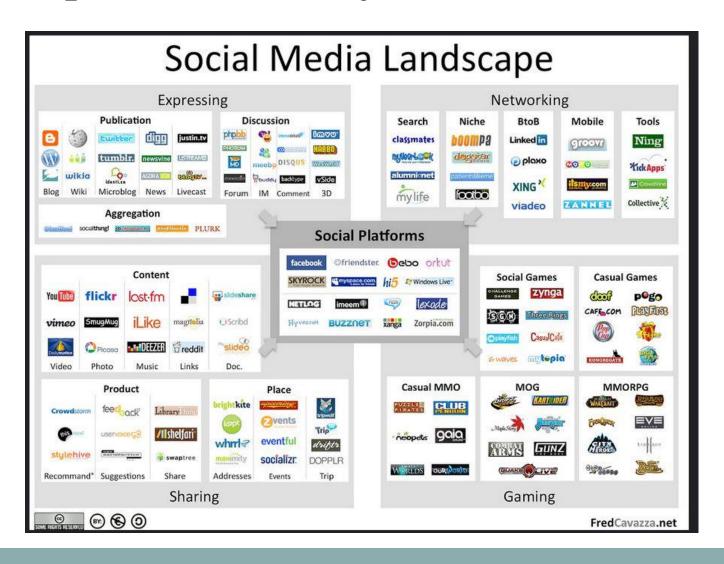
• A web presence doesn't just happen. It takes planning.

- Communication Plans Can Help
 - Determine goals
 - Identify message
 - Develop a timeframe for implementation
 - Establish how often you communicate
 - Reduce confusion

Questions to Ask

- Define Your Audience
 - Who do you want to reach?
- Determine Your Purpose
 - Why do you want to reach them?
- Identify Your Information
 - What do you want to tell them?
- Plan Your Steps
 - O How will you tell them?

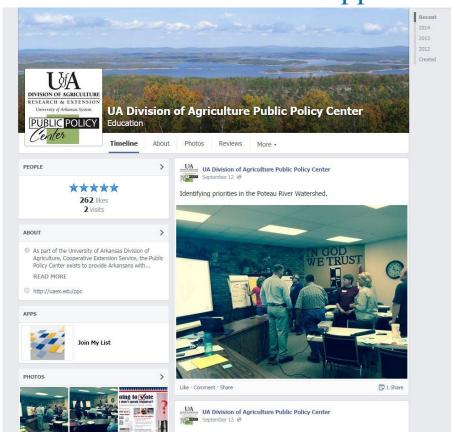
